25           (4) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the two  
26 appropriations in Schedule 20-945 Other Requirements, State Aid to Local  
27 Government Entities in Act 41 of the 2010 Regular Session of the Legislature  
28 payable to the town of Iota, one in the amount of \$10,000 and one in the amount of  
29 \$3,250, shall be deemed bona fide obligations through June 30, 2013 and all  
30 provisions of the cooperative endeavor agreements executed by and between the  
31 town of Iota and the Department of the Treasury, including, but not limited to the  
32 reporting requirements, shall be performed as agreed.

33           (5) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the appropriations  
34 in Schedule 20-945 Other Requirements, State Aid to Local Government Entities in  
35 Act 19 of the 2008 Regular Session of the Legislature payable to town of Delhi in  
36 the amount of \$17,147, shall be deemed a bona fide obligation through June 30, 2013  
37 and all provisions of the cooperative endeavor agreement executed by and between  
38 the town of Delhi and the Department of the Treasury, including, but not limited to  
39 the reporting requirements, shall be performed as agreed.

40           (6) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the appropriations  
41 in Schedule 20-945 Other Requirements, State Aid to Local Government Entities in  
42 Act 122 of the 2009 Regular Session of the Legislature payable to town of Delhi in

1 the amount of \$4,087, shall be deemed a bona fide obligation through June 30, 2013  
2 and all provisions of the cooperative endeavor agreement executed by and between  
3 the town of Delhi and the Department of the Treasury, including, but not limited to  
4 the reporting requirements, shall be performed as agreed.

5 (7) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the appropriations  
6 in Schedule 20-945 Other Requirements, State Aid to Local Government Entities in  
7 Act 41 of the 2010 Regular Session of the Legislature payable to town of Delhi in  
8 the amount of \$5,000, shall be deemed a bona fide obligation through June 30, 2013  
9 and all provisions of the cooperative endeavor agreement executed by and between  
10 the town of Delhi and the Department of the Treasury, including, but not limited to  
11 the reporting requirements, shall be performed as agreed.

12 (8) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the appropriations  
13 in Schedule 20-945 Other Requirements, State Aid to Local Government Entities in  
14 Act 41 of the 2010 Regular Session of the Legislature payable to town of Mamou in  
15 the amount of \$7,390, shall be deemed a bona fide obligation through June 30, 2013  
16 and all provisions of the cooperative endeavor agreement executed by and between  
17 the town of Mamou and the Department of the Treasury, including, but not limited  
18 to the reporting requirements, shall be performed as agreed."

31 Act in accordance with Article III, Section 18 or Article IV, Section 5(G) of the Louisiana  
32 Constitution, departments, agencies, and programs are authorized to expend monies prior  
33 to the effective date of any other Act of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature in  
34 preparation of carrying out the requirements of such Act by the effective date."
