TRANSPORTATION DEPT: Revises names of offices within DOTD

Report adopts Senate amendments to:

1. Require applications for funding of any flood-control projects to be made to the office of engineering by October first of each year.

Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:

1. Required emergency procedure manuals prepared by each levee board of commissioners to be submitted to the office of engineering, or its successor, and the Joint Legislative Committee on Transportation on or before December, 2011.

Report amends the bill to:

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

Proposed law renames the office of public works, hurricane flood protection and intermodal transportation, to the office of engineering.
