

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 1058 by Representative Fannin

APPROPRIATIONS: Appropriates funds for the expenses of the Louisiana Judiciary for Fiscal Year 2012-2013

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds \$4 million in State General Fund (Direct) by reducing the reduction to be implemented pursuant to a plan adopted by the Judicial Budgetary Control Board from \$6.1 million to \$2.1 million.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Appropriates funds for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 for the ordinary operating expenses of the judicial branch of government with total funding of \$162,949,765 from the following sources: \$142,862,434 out of the State General Fund (Direct); \$10,436,500 through interagency transfers from the Dept. of Children and Family Services; and, \$9,650,831 from statutory dedications out of the Judges' Supplemental Compensation Fund and the Trial Court Case Management Fund.

Funding for the ordinary operating expenses of the judicial branch of government is provided as follows:

Provides that the appropriations out of the State General Fund (Direct) contained in this Act shall be reduced by a total amount of \$2,130,662 pursuant to a plan adopted by the Judicial Budgetary Control Board or as approved by the La. Supreme Court.
