

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 1059 by Representative Fannin

APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Provides for supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2011-2012

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides for an extension of cooperative endeavor agreements for certain projects through June 30, 2013.
2. Provides for additional uncompensated care costs payments to the LSU hospitals subject to the funding appropriated in Act 12 of the 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature.
3. Provides for an appropriation from the Budget Stabilization Fund to the State General Fund in the amount of \$204.7 million to address the current year deficit.
4. Increased (decreased) appropriations as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by (\$12,262,632); Interagency Transfers by \$3,125,000; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$112,592,111; Statutory Dedications by \$20,479,251; and Federal Funds by \$4,285,255.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Adjusts supplemental appropriations for the current fiscal year to balance the FY2012 budget and provides for reductions in the current fiscal year to meet the requirements implemented in Executive Freeze Orders BJ 2011-12 and BJ 2012-3. Also provides for supplemental capital outlay appropriations.

Provides for net increases (decreases) in appropriations as follows: State General Fund (Direct) \$128,268,334; Interagency Transfers by \$18,956,481; Fees & Self-generated Revenues by \$137,268,046; Statutory Dedications by (\$88,429,505); and Federal Funds by \$9,210,379.

Provides for an appropriation from the Budget Stabilization Fund to the State General Fund in the amount of \$204.7 million to address the current year deficit.

Provides for an extension of cooperative endeavor agreements for certain projects through June 30, 2013 and provides for additional uncompensated care costs payments to the LSU hospitals subject to the funding appropriated in Act 12 of the 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
