Subject: Unlawful Sale of Dog or Cat	

CRIME/MISDEMEANOR EN SEE FISC NOTE LF RV See Note Page 1 of 1
Prohibits the sale of dogs or cats at certain public locations

Proposed legislation provides that it shall be unlawful for any person to offer for sale or sell any dog or cat on any highway, right-of-way, or public park, public playground, public swimming pool, any other public recreational area, flea market, or adjacent property to such locations, or any commercial or retail parking lot unless permission is granted by the owner of the parking lot.

Proposed legislation creates exceptions for cat or dog adoption days sponsored by animal welfare groups and sales occurring entirely on private property.

Proposed legislation provides penalties of a fine of not more than \$250 for a first violation and not more than \$1,000 for second or subsequent violations.
