AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 9:315.47 and to enact R.S. 9:315.46(C), relative to the suspension of licenses for failure to pay child support; to provide for modification or lifting of suspensions for partial compliance; to provide for a court order lifting the suspension of a license in certain circumstances; to provide for reinstatement of licenses for partial compliance; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 9:315.47 is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 9:315.46(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§315.46. Subsequent compliance with support order; compliance and partial compliance releases

* * *

C. At the request of an obligor who provides evidence of his ability to comply with the support order and who enters into a written agreement with the department, the department may issue a certificate of partial compliance requesting that the suspension be lifted or modified. The secretary of the department shall have the authority to promulgate rules and regulations and take such action as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

§315.47. Reissuance of license

The licensing authority shall issue, reissue, renew, or otherwise extend an obligor's license, in accordance with any applicable reinstatement fees or applicable

1 rules, upon receipt of a certified copy of a compliance or partial compliance release
2 from the department.
