Provides relative to employment and deployment of police from the levee districts within the Southeast La. Flood Protection Authority - East

**Purpose of Bill:** This bill authorizes the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority - East to employ a superintendent to supervise the police security personnel of all levee districts within its territorial jurisdiction. It also provides for the authority of the superintendent and the ability for the authority to assess the levee districts for the payment of the superintendent's salary, benefits and expenses.

In addition, this bill authorizes the authority to deploy police security personnel employed by one of its levee districts in another one of its levee districts, provided that the district providing the personnel is compensated for the deployment.



## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

This bill may decrease local governmental expenditures by approximately \$112,000 per year.
