

Prior law, relative to the hours the polls are open on election day, provided that the polls would open at 6:00 a.m. New law provides that the polls open at 7:00 a.m. for elections other than regularly scheduled congressional primary elections and elections held at the same time.

Existing law requires the registrar or a deputy registrar designated by him to remain in the office during election hours.

Prior law required the principal office of the registrar to open at 6:00 a.m. on election day. New law provides that the office shall open at 7:00 a.m. for elections other than regularly scheduled congressional primary elections and elections held at the same time.

Effective January 1, 2013.
