

Prior law required the registrar of voters, immediately upon receipt of an application to vote absentee by mail or during early voting, to enter the name of the applicant and his street or mailing address, ward, and precinct number on a list. Required the registrar to post the list in a conspicuous place accessible to the public at the entrance to his office.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 22, 2012).
