

Existing law creates the College and Career Readiness Commission to make recommendations for the development of statewide policies, guiding principles, and programs that address the current and future economic needs of the state and to promote student success in high school and in life beyond secondary education.

Existing law provides for commission membership. Prior law provided that the commission included one member of the La. Task Force on Workplace Competitiveness appointed by the governor. New law removes this member and adds a parent of a child with a disability or an adult with a disability appointed by the state superintendent of education.

Effective August 1, 2012.
