<u>Prior law</u> required that payment of salaries to House members and staff be by individual check, signed by the speaker of the House and permits use of a facsimile signature. <u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u>.

<u>Prior law</u> required that payment of salaries to Senate members and staff be by individual check, signed by a member of the Senate designated by the Senate president and countersigned by him and permits the use of facsimile signatures. <u>New law</u> requires that such checks be signed by the Senate president; otherwise retains <u>prior law</u>.

Effective July 1, 2012.
