

Prior law required that payment of salaries to House members and staff be by individual check, signed by the speaker of the House and permits use of a facsimile signature. New law retains prior law.

Prior law required that payment of salaries to Senate members and staff be by individual check, signed by a member of the Senate designated by the Senate president and countersigned by him and permits the use of facsimile signatures. New law requires that such checks be signed by the Senate president; otherwise retains prior law.

Effective July 1, 2012.
