

Existing law provides for the confidentiality of taxpayer records and for exceptions under which information may be shared with other public entities.

New law adds an exception, beginning Sept. 1, 2012, for the secretary of the Dept. of Revenue to annually disclose a list which contains only the name, address, and last four digits of a taxpayer's social security number to the La. Clerks of Court Association, hereinafter "association". Provides that the list shall be in an electronic format without cost to the association.

New law requires that upon written request of any district clerk of court, the association shall provide to the clerk the electronic list for the respective parish.

New law provides that neither the list provided by the secretary or by the association shall be considered a public record; however, provides that the jury venire roll constructed by the district clerk of court shall be considered a public record.

Effective August 1, 2012.
