

Existing law requires that parish tax assessors receive annual compensation based on the following compensation schedule depending on the population of the parish in which they serve:

<u>Population</u>	<u>Compensation</u>
Greater than 250,000	\$108,290
50,001 to 249,999	\$ 98,290
50,000 or less	\$ 88,290

New law increases the salary of the assessor in Lafayette parish from \$98,290 to \$108,290 by requiring that the salary of the Lafayette Parish assessor be the salary of assessors in parishes with a population greater than 250,000.

Effective July 1, 2012.
