

Requests the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to study the advantages and disadvantages of enacting a state law to limit the salary amount paid to public school administrators, except local superintendents, chief financial officers, and principals, to the amount paid to teachers in the same school system and to report its findings and recommendations to the House and Senate education committees at least 60 days prior to the 2013 R.S. Provides that the study include such factors as:

- (1) Current salary differentiations among teachers and school administrators in the same school system (except those specified above).
- (2) Best practices in salary payment procedures and strategies for achieving parity.
- (3) A model organizational chart which shows the administrative positions necessary for a successful school system.
- (4) Any applicable policies, rules, regulations, and laws.
