

Relative to child support enforcement, existing law provides for an income assignment by the court directing a payor to withhold a certain amount for current support. Also, provides that an employer is not civilly liable for honoring a court's income assignment order.

New law retains existing law except it provides for a change in terminology to allow for consistency throughout the law.

Effective August 1, 2012.
