

Existing law, in pertinent part, authorizes the Dept. of Children and Family Services to intercept, encumber, freeze, or seize unemployment compensation benefits in cases where there is a child support arrearage or child support overpayment made to a custodial parent.

Proposed law clarifies existing law by specifying that child support overpayments are excluded from recovery from unemployment compensation benefits.

Effective August 1, 2012.
