2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:1821(B), relative to the Municipal Employees' Retirement
3	System; to provide for membership of the boards of trustees; to provide for an
4	effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 11:1821(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1821. Board of trustees; membership; term of office; oath of office; compensation;
9	voting power; vacancies

11	B. The board shall consist of nine <u>eleven</u> trustees, six of whom shall be active
12	and contributing members of the system with at least ten years of creditable service,
13	elected by the members of this system in accordance with the election rules
14	prescribed by the board; one of whom shall be the president of the Louisiana
15	Municipal Association who shall serve as an ex officio member during his tenure;
16	one of whom shall be the chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, but after April
17	15, 1980, his place shall be taken by the chairman of the Senate Committee on

 Retirement Committee, or his designee, who shall serve as a voting ex officio

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 member; and one of whom shall be the chairman of the House Committee on

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 Retirement Committee of the Legislature of Louisiana, or his designee, who shall

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 serve as a voting ex officio member; one of whom shall be the commissioner of

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 administration or his designee; and one of whom shall be the state treasurer or

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 his designee.

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8 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2013; if vetoed by the 9 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this act shall become effective on 10 June 30, 2013, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides for the membership of the board of trustees for the Municipal Employees' Retirement System (MERS).

Proposed law provides for two additional members on the MERS board of trustees:

(1) The commissioner of administration.

(2) The state treasurer.

Effective June 30, 2013.
