APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Michael Higgins v. State of Louisiana, through DOTD, Office of Highways"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2013-  
3 2014 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Michael J. Higgins  
4 v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development,  
5 Office of Highways"; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$100,000.00) Dollars  
8 is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year  
9 2013-2014 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Michael J. Higgins  
10 v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development, Office  
11 of Highways", bearing Number 85-630, Division "A" on the docket of the Twenty-Second  
12 Judicial District Court, parish of Washington, state of Louisiana.

13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013; if vetoed by the governor  
14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
15 2013, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
