Hazel HB No. 173

Abstract: Extends the definition of an infant for purposes of safe haven relinquishment to include children up to 12 months old.

<u>Present law</u> provides a mechanism whereby any parent may relinquish the care of an infant to the state in safety, anonymity, and without fear of prosecution.

<u>Present law</u> defines an infant as a child not previously subjected to abuse or neglect, who is not more than 30 days old.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the age requirement in the definition of an infant <u>from</u> "not more than thirty days old" to "not more than 12 months old" and otherwise retains present law.
