1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:130.532(A), relative to the Hopkins Street Economic
3	Development District in New Iberia; to provide relative to the membership of the
4	district's board of commissioners; to provide for technical changes; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
8	Louisiana.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 33:130.532(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
11	§130.532. Board of commissioners; members; officers; employees
12	A.(1) The district shall be governed by a board of commissioners consisting
13	of seven voting members appointed by the Hopkins Street Revitalization
14	Association, Incorporated as set out herein provided by this Subsection. The initial
15	term shall be two years. At the termination of the initial terms of office each term
16	thereafter shall be for three years. A board member may succeed himself.
17	(2)(a) One name submitted member shall be appointed by the Hopkins Street
18	Revitalization Association, Incorporated.
19	(b) One name submitted member shall be appointed by the Southwest
20	Leadership Training and Development Association.

1	(c) One name submitted member shall be appointed by the Leo J. Hardy
2	Branch Iberia Parish Chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of
3	Colored People.
4	(d) The state representative, or his designee, from <u>the</u> state representative
5	district number forty-eight that includes all or a majority of the Hopkins Street
6	Economic Development District, shall be a member.
7	(e) The state senator, or his designee, from the state senate district number
8	twenty-two that includes all or a majority of the Hopkins Street Economic
9	Development District, shall be a member.
10	(f) The New Iberia City Council member representing city council district
11	number two, or his designee, shall be a member.
12	(g) The New Iberia City Council member representing city council district
13	number five, or his designee, shall be a member.
14	(h) The mayor of the city of New Iberia, or his designee, who shall serve as
15	a non-voting <u>nonvoting</u> member.
16	(3) Each nominee appointee pursuant to Subparagraph (2)(a), (b), or (c) of
17	this Subsection shall be submitted to the board of commissioners for confirmation.
18	(4) Nominees for Appointees to the board of commissioners shall be
19	submitted to the secretary-treasurer of the district within forty-five days after
20	notification of a board vacancy. In the event that the entity responsible for the
21	nomination appointment of such member fails to provide the board of commissioners
22	with a nominee an appointee for each such vacancy to be filled, within forty-five
23	days of such vacancy, the board of commissioners shall appoint an interim successor
24	to serve until the position is filled by the respective nominating appointing entity as
25	provided for in Paragraph $A(2)$ of this Section (2) of this Subsection.

Abstract: Provides relative the membership on the board of commissioners of the Hopkins Street Economic Development District in New Iberia.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the creation of the Hopkins Street Economic Development District. Further provides that the district shall be governed by a board of commissioners consisting of seven members appointed by the Hopkins Street Revitalization Assoc.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the district shall be governed by a board of commissioners consisting of seven voting members. <u>Present law</u> provides that the Hopkins Street Revitalization Assoc., the Southwest Leadership Training and Development Assoc., and the local chapter of the National Assoc. for the Advancement of Colored People submit one nomination each for membership. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that these entities each appoint a member.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the board of commissioners shall include the state representative, or his designee, from state representative district number 48. Further provides that the board of commissioners shall include the state senator, or his designee, from state senate district number 22.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes requirements so that the state representative, or his designee, shall be from the state representative district that includes all or a majority of the Hopkins Street Economic Development District. Also provides that the state senator, or his designee, shall be from the state senate district that includes all or a majority of the Hopkins Street Economic Development District.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the board of commissioners shall include one name submitted by the Leo J. Hardy Branch of the National Assoc. for the Advancement of Colored People.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the board of commissioners shall include one name submitted by the Iberia Parish Chapter of the National Assoc. for the Advancement of Colored People.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the board of commissioners shall include the New Iberia City Council members representing city council districts numbers two and five. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that such board members may appoint designated persons to represent their respective districts on the board; otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

Proposed law provides for technical corrections.
