AN ACT

2	To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2013-
3	2014 to be used to pay the consent judgment against the Department of
4	Transportation and Development in the suit entitled "Jeremy LeBlanc v. Katrina M.
5	Libersat, et al"; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand and No/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars is
8	hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2013-
9	2014 to be used to pay the consent judgment against the Department of Transportation and
10	Development in the suit entitled "Jeremy LeBlanc v. Katrina M. Libersat, et al", bearing
11	Number 115776E on the docket of the Sixteenth Judicial District Court, parish of Iberia,
12	state of Louisiana.
13	Section 2. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand and No/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars is
14	hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2013-
15	2014, to be paid to the Department of Health and Hospitals for Medicaid reimbursement in
16	the suit entitled "Jeremy LeBlanc v. Katrina M. Libersat, et al", bearing Number 115776E
17	on the docket of the Sixteenth Judicial District Court, parish of Iberia, state of Louisiana.
