INSURANCE DEPARTMENT: Changes composition and requirements relative to Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:32(A)(1)(introductory paragraph), (i), (l), and (n) and (3) and
3	to repeal R.S. 22:32(A)(2), relative to the Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity
4	within the Department of Insurance; to require the deputy commissioner of the
5	division of minority affairs to serve as the committee chairperson; to make changes
6	to the list of associations that may submit nominees to be considered for appointment
7	to the committee; to remove the requirement that the Senate approve gubernatorial
8	appointments to the committee; and to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 22:32(A)(1)(introductory paragraph), (i), (l), and (n) and (3) are
11	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
12	§32. Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity
13	A.(1) There is hereby created within the Department of Insurance, in the
14	division of minority affairs, the Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity. The
15	committee shall be composed of twenty-three members. Twenty-two members shall
16	be appointed by the governor and shall serve at his pleasure. The deputy
17	commissioner for minority affairs shall serve ex officio as the twenty-third member.
18	The deputy commissioner shall serve as chairperson of the committee. Four
19	members shall be appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the Louisiana
20	chapter of The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the

Abstract: Makes changes to the associations who may nominate members to serve on the Dept. of Insurance's Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity.

<u>Present law</u> provides for an Advisory Committee on Equal Opportunity within the Dept. of Insurance, to which the governor appoints 22 members. Further provides that the governor's choice of appointees shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the deputy commissioner for minority affairs will serve as chairperson of the committee.

<u>Present law</u> provides a list of groups and associations that will each be responsible for nominating one person to be considered for appointment to the committee.

<u>Proposed law</u> makes changes to the list of associations responsible for nominating persons to the committee.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the Health Insurance Association of America, the National Independent Insurance Agents, and the National Business League from the list and adds the La. Association of Health Plans, the Independent Insurance Agents and Brokers of La., and the La. Black Chamber of Commerce.

<u>Present law</u> provides that members of the committee shall serve without compensation, except for compensation for mileage and meals incurred in the connection with the attendance of committee meetings or committee business.

<u>Proposed law</u> clarifies that members of the committee shall serve without compensation, except for reasonable reimbursement for necessary travel and expenses incurred in connection with the attendance of committee meetings or committee business.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals provision of <u>present law</u> that requires Senate confirmation of gubernatorial appointments to the committee.
