FISH/FISHING. Prohibits the sale, possession, or importation of red snapper in the state or in the waters of the state. (8/1/13)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 56:327.2, relative to the sale, possession, or importation of red snapper; to
3	provide certain terms, conditions, requirements, and prohibitions; to provide
4	penalties for violations; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 56:327.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§327.2. Sale, exchange, possession, or importation of red snapper prohibited
8	No person shall purchase, sell, exchange, or offer for sale or exchange,
9	or possess or import with intent to sell or exchange red snapper within the state
10	or state waters. Violation of the provisions of this Section shall constitute a class
11	5-B violation.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the sale, exchange, or offer for sale or exchange, or possession or importation of red snapper with intent to sell within the state water boundaries. Further provides that a violation of <u>proposed law</u> is a class 5-B violation.
