SENATE BILL NO. 160

BY SENATOR DORSEY-COLOMB

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

PUBLIC WORKS. Identifies which Department of Public Works is referenced in certain groundwater conservation districts. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact a definition for a reference in certain districts; to provide relative to groundwater
3 conservation districts; to specify which department of public works; and to provide
4 for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 **Section 1. Whenever the "director of the Department of Public Works" is**
7 **referred to in any provision of law concerning a groundwater conservation district**
8 **created by law, it shall mean the director of the Department of Public Works or his**
9 **designee of the municipality having the greatest population within the district.**

10 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
11 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
12 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
13 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
14 effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

Proposed law provides that whenever the "director of the Department of Public Works" is referred to in any provision of law concerning a groundwater conservation district created by law, it shall mean the director of the Department of Public Works or his designee of the municipality having the greatest population within the district.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
