A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Zachary Fitzpatrick, a native of Holden, Louisiana, is a junior biochemistry major at Louisiana State University (LSU) in the College of Science with minors in chemistry and political science; and

WHEREAS, upon graduating from LSU, Zachary plans to pursue a joint medical degree and Ph.D. in neuroscience; and

WHEREAS, Zachary's goal is to conduct translational biomedical research to develop gene and cellular therapeutics for neurodegenerative diseases; and

WHEREAS, Zachary recently developed a novel proposal for a gene therapeutic agent for the treatment of Parkinson's disease, and this work earned Zachary an honorable mention from the Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship and Excellence in Education Program; and

WHEREAS, to further execute his gene therapy proposal, Zachary has also worked with Howard Hughes Medical Institute Investigator Dr. Katherine High, a world-renowned medical scientist, at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia; and

WHEREAS, the Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship, which was established by congress in 1986, is a federal scholarship awarded to select college students with the purpose of providing a continuing source of highly qualified scientists, mathematicians, and engineers by awarding scholarships to college sophomores and juniors; and

WHEREAS, Zachary Fitzpatrick merits a special measure of commendation for his outstanding accomplishments, as a citizen, scientist, and scholar.
