Broadwater HB No. 96

**Abstract:** Authorizes the board of commissioners of waterworks districts to appoint a fiscal agent for a period of up to three years rather than just one year.

<u>Present law</u> allows police juries to divide their respective parishes into waterworks districts.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the police jury shall appoint commissioners to govern waterworks districts.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a waterworks district shall elect a fiscal agent every year. Requires an advertisement in a local newspaper prior to each election.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows a waterworks district to elect a fiscal agent to serve a period of up to three years. Further authorizes a district to renew the election of a fiscal agent for one term without the advertisement required by <u>present law</u>.

Effective on the first Monday in June (June 2), 2014.
