Dove HB No. 204

Abstract: Relative to the Bayou Cane Fire Protection District in Terrebonne Parish, increases the membership of the governing board <u>from</u> five <u>to</u> seven.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes parish governing authorities to create or enlarge fire protection districts in the manner and subject to the limitations and restrictions contained in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides generally that fire protection districts are governed by a board of five commissioners that are appointed by the parish governing authority if no municipality is included within the boundaries of a district.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the governing authority of Terrebonne Parish to increase membership of the governing board of the Bayou Cane Fire Protection District <u>from</u> five <u>to</u> seven. Provides that the parish governing authority shall appoint such additional members and provide for their initial terms. <u>Proposed law</u> otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs</u> to the <u>original</u> bill.

1. Authorizes an increase in the number of members of the governing board of the Bayou Cane Fire Protection District rather than increasing such membership statutorily.
