Guinn HB No. 395

**Abstract:** Requires that the words "situs inversus totalis" be exhibited on the driver's license, regardless of its class, and special identification cards of persons who submit documentation from a physician certifying that they have the condition.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the words "situs inversus totalis" be exhibited on the driver's license, regardless of its class, and special identification cards, upon request and presentation of documentation from a physician certifying that the person has such condition.
