Provides relative to employment discrimination

<u>Proposed law</u> states that any employment discrimination suit filed in district court or with the La. Commission on Human Rights for any other reasons besides age, disabilities, race, color, religion, sex, national origin, pregnancy, childbirth or related medication condition, sickle cell trait, or genetic information shall be dismissed and considered frivolous. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that plaintiffs/claimants of such "frivolous" suits may be liable to the employer for reasonable damages, attorney fees, and court costs.
