## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 4, after "firemen;" and before "and" insert "to provide exceptions; to provide
definitions;"

- 5 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 20 in their entirety and insert the following:

6	"A. Any volunteer fireman who renders emergency or rescue
7	services while in the performance of his duties at the scene of an emergency
8	shall not be individually liable for civil damages as a result of acts or
9	omissions in rendering the emergency or rescue services. The immunity
10	provided herein shall apply to all acts or omissions except those intentionally
11	designed to harm or those grossly negligent acts or omissions that result in
12	harm to person or property.
13	B. A volunteer fireman shall not be individually liable for civil
14	damages as a result of acts or omissions when:
15	(1) Rendering firefighting emergency or rescue services while in the
16	performance of his duties at the scene of an emergency; or
17	(2) Conducting normal functions of the fire department or
18	organization as defined by Subsection E of this Section.
19	C. The immunity provided by Paragraph (B)(2) of this Section shall
20	only apply to liability for civil damages as a result of acts or omissions
21	resulting in injury or death of another volunteer fireman or damage to his
22	property.
23	D. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to any of the
24	<u>following:</u>
25	(1) Travel by a volunteer fireman while in a personal vehicle,
26	including but not limited to travel to and from the scene of a fire, emergency,
27	<u>or rescue.</u>
28	(2) Damages caused by the intentional act or omission or gross
29	negligence or willful or wanton misconduct of the volunteer fireman."
