Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original Senate Bill No. 223 by Senator Mills

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 7, change "**the shale**" to "**shallow**"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 11, change "**deeper**" to "**deep**"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 16, change "**manufacturing**" to "**fabrication**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 3, delete lines 16 and 17

9 AMENDMENT NO. 5

10 On page 3, line 18, change "**(7)**" to "**(6)**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 6

12 On page 3, delete lines 20 through 23, and insert:

13 **"(7) One member from each of Louisiana's coastal ports appointed by each**
 14 **port's executive director.**

15 **"(8) One member from each of Louisiana's deep draft ports appointed by each**
 16 **port's executive director."**

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 3, line 29, after "**(2)**" insert "**(a)**"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 8

20 On page 4, between lines 9 and 10, insert:

21 **"(b)The authority shall not be eligible to apply for or receive funding from the**
 22 **Port Construction and Development Priority Program as provided in R.S. 34:3451 et**
 23 **seq.**

24 **"(c) The authority shall be prohibited from advising on any matter related to the**
 25 **Port Construction and Development Priority Program."**

26 AMENDMENT NO. 9

27 On page 4, line 10, after "**(3)**" delete "**The**" and insert "**Not later than May 1, 2015, and not**
 28 **later than May 1 annually thereafter, the**" and delete "**periodically**"

29 AMENDMENT NO. 10

30 On page 4, between lines 12 and 13, insert:

31 **"(4) The authority may call upon the expertise of others with knowledge of Gulf**
 32 **of Mexico deep water exploration and production, including but not limited to the**

1 Louisiana Mid-Continent Oil and Gas Association, the Louisiana Oil and Gas
2 Association, the American Petroleum Institute, the National Ocean Industries
3 Association, the Gulf Economic Survival Team, Chambers of Commerce, Louisiana
4 universities, fabrication companies, and port organizations.

5 (5) Executive agencies and departments of the state represented on the authority
6 may enter into interagency agreements to share costs necessary to perform authority
7 duties, functions, and responsibilities."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 11

9 On page 4, between lines 21 and 22, insert:

10 "F. The provisions of this Chapter shall terminate on June 30, 2018."
