5	loss of its coast and wetlands, a challenge that is threatening its communities, industry and
6	small businesses, and culture; and
7	WHEREAS, this crisis has created a need for a concerted effort involving multiple
8	state and federal agencies, as well as local levee boards, parish officials, private industries,
9	and concerned citizens; and
10	WHEREAS, the legislature has mandated that the Coastal Protection and Restoration
11	Authority develop and implement a comprehensive coastal protection and restoration master
12	plan that will include numerous coastal restoration and protection projects that will protect
13	Louisiana's communities, its industry and small businesses, the nation's critical energy
14	infrastructure, and the state's bountiful natural resources; and
15	WHEREAS, Louisiana's industry and small businesses are also threatened by our
16	coastal crisis and will be an integral part in participating in the numerous infrastructure
17	projects that will be necessary to restore the state's coasts and protect its people.
