The annual report shall be submitted to the president of the Senate and speaker of the House of 24 Representatives not later than January first of the year following the end of 25 the fiscal year for which the report is prepared.
- 27 B. The director shall submit a report at the end of each month to the 28 House Committee on Appropriations summarizing the contracts and dollar 29 value of such contracts awarded that month over which the office of 30 contractual review has power and authority.
