DIGEST

Dorsey-Colomb (SB 160)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that in any provision of law applicable to a groundwater conservation district located in a parish with population, according to the 2010 decennial census, in excess of four hundred thousand, the term "director of the Department of Public Works" shall mean the director of the municipal Department of Public Works for the municipality located in the district with the greatest population.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs to the original bill

- 1. Adds to the defined terms the provisions regarding personnel of the Department of Natural Resources.
- 2. Adds requirement that the groundwater conservation district created by law include a parish with a population in excess of 400,000.
