I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for House Bill No. <u>162</u> of the 2013 Regular Session by Representative <u>Pearson</u>, proposing to <u>amend Art. VII, Section 23(B) and (C)</u> of the Constitution.

HB 162 provides relative to maximum authorized millage rates and increases in millage rates without voter approval.

II. CONCLUSION

The proposed measure cannot be accomplished statutorily.

HB 162 proposes to amend existing constitutional provisions relative to the adjustment of millage rates which can only be accomplished by a constitutional amendment.
