2	To amend and reenact R.S. 30:215(A), relative to nonexclusive geophysical permits; to
3	provide certain terms, conditions, and requirements for certain nonexclusive
4	geophysical permits; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 30:215(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§215. Nonexclusive geophysical permits
8	A. A nonexclusive permit to conduct seismic, geophysical, or geological
9	surveying upon state-owned lands, including water bottoms, shall be valid for one
10	year from the date of issuance. However, if operations commence within the year
11	and are ceased due to unforeseen circumstances, the term may be extended for up to
12	one year from the cessation of operations by the secretary of Department of Natural
13	Resources. The permittee shall pay to the office of mineral resources at the time
14	of application for the seismic permit a fee. Such fee shall be determined by the
15	State Mineral and Energy Board at least every twelve month months or more as
16	often as necessary. The fee shall be based upon market value but shall be no more
17	than thirty dollars and no less than five dollars per acre.
18	* * *
19	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
20	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
21	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
