2	To amend and reenact R.S. 32:300.5(A), the introductory paragraph of 300.5(B),
3	407(A)(2)(a), and 408(A)(1), relative to driver distractions; to prohibit social
4	networking while operating a motor vehicle; to provide for exclusions from certain
5	definitions; to provide for penalties; to provide for knowledge of driver distractions;
6	and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 32:300.5(A), the introductory paragraph of 300.5(B), 407(A)(2)(a),
9	and $408(A)(1)$ are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§300.5. Use of certain wireless telecommunications devices for text messaging and
11	social networking prohibited
12	A.(1) Except as provided in Subsection B of this Section, no person shall
13	operate any motor vehicle upon any public road or highway of this state while using
14	a wireless telecommunications device to write, send, or read a text-based
15	communication. For purposes of this Section, a person shall not be deemed to be
16	writing, reading, or sending a text message if the person reads, selects, or enters a
17	telephone number or name in a wireless telecommunications device for the purpose
18	of making a telephone call.
19	(2) No person shall operate any motor vehicle upon any public road or
20	highway of this state while using a wireless telecommunications device to access,
21	read, or post to a social networking site.
22	(3)(a) "Wireless telecommunications device" means a cellular telephone, a
23	text-messaging device, a personal digital assistant, a stand alone computer, or any
24	other substantially similar wireless device that is readily removable from the vehicle

1	and is used to write, send, or read text or data through manual input. A "wireless
2	telecommunications device" shall not include any device or component that is
3	permanently affixed to a motor vehicle. It does not include citizens band radios,
4	citizens band radio hybrids, commercial two-way radio communication devices, <b><u>two-</u></b>
5	way radio transmitters or receivers used by licensees of the Federal
6	Communication Commission in the Amateur Radio Service, or electronic
7	communication devices with a push-to-talk function.
8	(b) "Write, send, or read a text-based communication" means using a wireless
9	telecommunications device to manually communicate with any person by using a
10	text-based communication referred to as a text message, instant message, or
11	electronic mail.

8	§408. Examination of applicants required; classes of licenses
9	A.(1) Except as otherwise provided, every applicant must pass a written
10	knowledge and skills test for a motor vehicle representative of the type of motor
11	vehicle he operates or expects to operate, or provide evidence on a form approved
12	by the department that he has successfully passed the written knowledge test and a
13	driving or skills test administered by an authorized third party. In addition to the
14	specialized knowledge and skills tests, each such examination shall include: a test
15	of the applicant's eyesight; his ability to understand highway signs regulating,
16	warning, and directing traffic; his knowledge of railroad and highway grade crossing
17	safety; his knowledge of sharing the road with motorcycles and tractor/trailer trucks;
18	his knowledge of the economic effects of littering; his knowledge of distracted
19	driving issues; and his knowledge of all relevant traffic regulations.
