18	"(2) Upon request by the Department of Economic Development, the Department
19	of Revenue and the Louisiana Workforce Commission shall provide any information
20	in their possession needed by the Department of Economic Development for
21	preparation of the report. The Department of Economic Development shall not
22	disclose any confidential data provided, and shall not include any confidential
23	information in the report in an individually identifiable form.
24	B. The report shall include:
25	(1) A complete listing of each state economic development program which the
26	division of administration has agreed should be included in the report and the agency
27	or corporation which administers them, if any.
28	(2) A description of how the agency or corporation administers its program and how
29	that administration serves to promote, attract, and retain commerce and industry in
30	the state.
31	(3) The total direct cost of benefits provided under each economic development
32	program for the preceding two fiscal years, together with an estimate of the projected
33	direct cost for the current and next two fiscal years.
34	(4) The following performance data, including both direct and indirect impact, for
35	each economic development program for the two-fiscal year period being reported,
36	and, beginning with the report issued on November 15, 2007, a comparison to the
37	two fiscal years previously reported and the average of all prior fiscal years
38	previously reported, or the reasons why such data is not available:
39	(a) The dollar amount of new investment in physical assets in the state.

1	(b) The actual number and gross payroll of new permanent full and part-time jobs
2	created during the two-year period and the number and payroll of jobs created in
3	previously reported periods.
4	(c) The actual number and gross payroll of jobs retained as compared to the number
5	and payroll of jobs existing prior to the entry of the employers into a program.
6	(d) Wage rates and benefits of the new permanent full-time and part-time jobs
7	created, and those of the jobs retained, as compared to the wage rates and benefits
8	existing prior to the entry of the employers into the program.
9	(e) Tax revenues generated by employers participating in the programs, as
10	determined by the division of administration based upon tax data and information for
11	all employers participating in such programs which shall be supplied to the division
12	by the Department of Revenue, and certified by the Revenue Estimating Conference.
13	(5) An estimate of the total direct and indirect economic impact for each economic
14	development program on Louisiana based upon the performance data provided for
15	in Paragraphs (B)(3) and (4).
16	B.(1) The report in each year shall include at least twenty-five percent of the
17	economic development programs within the Department of Economic Development.
18	Each economic development program within the department shall be included in the
19	report at least once every four years. New economic development programs created
20	within the department shall be included in the report not later than two years after the
21	year of creation.
22	(2) The report shall include, as applicable, the following:
23	(a) A list of all state economic development programs within the Department of
24	Economic Development, including program title and statutory citation.
25	(b) A description of the economic development programs covered by the report,
26	including the purposes of the programs, qualifying businesses, type of incentive, and
27	how administered.
28	(c) For the initial report and subsequent reports of an economic development
29	program covering fiscal year periods since the last report, based upon actual data to
30	the extent available and upon estimates to the extent actual data is not available, the
31	amount of incentives issued; the administrative cost of the program; jobs, wages,
32	capital investment, and any other economic benefit associated with utilization of the
33	program, including the amount of capital investment and the number and gross
34	payroll of permanent full and part-time jobs created and retained; economic impact
35	of the program, including impact on state tax revenues; and the overall impact of the
36	program.
37	(d) For the current and next fiscal year, estimates of all of the following information
38	regarding each economic development program covered in the report:
39	(i) The amount of incentives issued.
40	(ii) The administrative cost of the program.
41	(iii) Jobs, wages, capital investment, and any other economic benefit associated with
42	utilization of the program.
43	(iv) Economic impact of the program, including impact on state tax revenues.
44	(v) The overall impact of the program.
