HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 282 by Representative Willmott

PARISH/JEFFERSON: Provides relative to appeals of certain administrative adjudication hearings in Jefferson Parish

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Authorizes any party aggrieved by any administrative adjudication to appeal to the appropriate district court.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 13:2575) authorizes any municipality or parish to prescribe civil fines for violation of public health, housing, fire code, environmental, and historic district ordinances. Further authorizes any municipality or parish to establish an administrative adjudication hearing procedure for violations of such ordinances. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 13:2575.1) establishes additional, supplemental definitions and procedures relative to <u>present law</u> exclusively for Jefferson Parish. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 13:2575(H)) authorizes any person found in violation of a public health, housing, fire code, environmental, or historic district ordinance by a hearing officer to appeal the decision to the appropriate district court.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and, in Jefferson Parish, further authorizes any party aggrieved by an administrative adjudication to appeal a decision of a hearing officer under <u>present law</u>. Requires such appeal to be filed in the appropriate district court.
