I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for Senate Bill No. <u>56</u> of the 2013 Regular Session by Senator <u>Morrell</u>, proposing to <u>amend Const. Art. VII, Section 18(G)(1)(a)(iv) of the Constitution.</u>

Excludes owners who are permanently totally disabled from the requirement that they annually certify to the assessor the amount of their adjusted gross income in order to the receive the special assessment level.

II. CONCLUSION

The proposed measure cannot be accomplished statutorily.

Since the requirements for receiving the special assessment level are provided by the constitution, an amendment or repeal of those requirements can only be accomplished by a constitutional amendment.
