SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Clarifies language as to students earning college credit for qualifying Advanced Placement examination performance instead of for Advanced Placement courses.

Requests the Board of Regents, in consultation with the postsecondary education management boards, to develop a uniform policy regarding the acceptance of college credit earned by students through Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate examinations.
