
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to Original House Concurrent Resolution No. 120 by Representative Harrison

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 2 through 4 and insert:

3 "To memorialize the Congress of the United States to study the causes, effects,
4 prevention, and treatment of early mortality syndrome in the national and
5 international shrimp industry and take all appropriate actions necessary to fully
6 protect the shrimp industry in Louisiana and other states from this disease."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 20 and insert the following:

9 "WHEREAS, Congress should fully utilize and bring to bear all available means of
10 research and study to determine the causes, effects, prevention, and treatment of
11 early mortality syndrome in the shrimp industry and take all appropriate actions
12 necessary to fully protect the shrimp industry in Louisiana and other states from this
13 disease; and"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 3

15 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 10 and insert the following:

16 "WHEREAS, throughout the Gulf of Mexico the shrimp industry in Louisiana and
17 other states is a multibillion dollar industry of vital importance to the economic
18 well-being of the region, and is still threatened by and suffering from the enormous
19 impacts of recent natural and manmade disasters.
20 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
21 memorialize the Congress of the United States to study the causes, effects,
22 prevention, and treatment of early mortality syndrome in the national and
23 international shrimp industry and take all appropriate actions necessary to fully
24 protect the shrimp industry in Louisiana and other states from this disease."
