## **DIGEST**

Directs the attorney general to review the laws relative to lobbying by public servants and the use of public funds for lobbying, public relations, and related purposes and to report thereon, including any recommendations related thereto, to the House and Senate governmental affairs committees by Sept. 15, 2013. Requests the House and Senate governmental affairs committees to meet and to function as a joint committee to study and make recommendations relative to lobbying by public servants and the use of public funds for lobbying, public relations, and related purposes to the legislature no later than 30 days prior to the convening of the 2014 R.S.
