## Thompson (SB 187)

<u>Prior law</u> provided for an exception as dispenser to a veterinarian who dispenses negligible amounts of controlled substances or drugs of concern as identified by rule.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> to remove the dispenser exception for a veterinarian who dispenses negligible amounts of controlled substances or drugs of concern as identified by rule.

<u>New law</u> provides a veterinarian exception to the Prescription Monitoring Program.

<u>Prior law</u> included the president of the La. State Board of Veterinary Medicine and the president of the La. Veterinary Medical Association as members of the Prescription Monitoring Program Advisory Council. <u>New law</u> removes them from the council.

<u>Prior law</u> authorizes the La. Board of Pharmacy to levy and collect an annual fee from veterinarians with the authority to prescribe or dispense controlled dangerous substances. <u>New law</u> removes this authority.

Effective upon signature of the governor (May 23, 2013).
