HOUSE BILL NO. 23

BY REPRESENTATIVE BURFORD

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:783(D)(7), relative to expenses of the clerks of court; to
3 authorize an automobile expense allowance for the clerks of court for certain
4 parishes; to require the purchase of automobile insurance for bodily injury and
5 property damage; to allocate surplus funds to the expense allowance; to prohibit
6 additional expenses from being paid by the state or local governing authority; and
7 to provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 13:783(D)(7) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §783. Expenses of clerk's office

14 (7) In Acadia Parish, Bienville Parish, Bossier Parish, Caddo Parish,
15 Cameron Parish, Claiborne Parish, DeSoto Parish, East Feliciana Parish, Franklin
16 Parish, Iberia Parish, Lincoln Parish, Morehouse Parish, Natchitoches Parish,
17 Ouachita Parish, Red River Parish, St. Charles Parish, St. Helena Parish, St. Landry
18 Parish, St. Tammany Parish, Tangipahoa Parish, Vermilion Parish, Washington
19 Parish, Webster Parish, West Baton Rouge Parish, and West Feliciana Parish, the
20 clerks of the district courts of those parishes may receive an automobile expense
21 allowance equal to fifteen percent of their annual salary provided the clerk of court
22 maintains three hundred thousand dollars of automobile insurance per accident for
23 bodily injury and one hundred thousand dollars of automobile insurance per accident
24 for property damage. The expense allowance shall come from surplus funds in each

1 of the offices of the clerks of court and at no additional expense to the state or local
2 governing authority.
