

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Concurrent Resolution No. 120 by Representative Harrison

PUBLIC HEALTH: Memorializes Congress to study the causes, effects, prevention, and treatment of early mortality syndrome in the national and international shrimp industry and take all appropriate actions necessary to fully protect the shrimp industry in Louisiana.

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Removes language memorializing Congress to ban all imported shrimp from several countries.
2. Adds language memorializing Congress to study the causes, effects, prevention, and treatment of early mortality syndrome in the national and international shrimp industry and take all appropriate actions necessary to fully protect the shrimp industry in Louisiana and other states from this disease.
