2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:1981(B) and to enact R.S. 33:2201(B)(21), relative to
3	survivor's benefits for firemen and law enforcement officers; to provide for
4	compensation for the surviving spouses and children of firemen and law enforcement
5	officers employed by certain Indian tribes or tribal units; to provide for the definition
6	of firemen and law enforcement officer; and to provide for related matters.
