The proposed legislation creates the Task Force on Textbooks and Instructional Materials for the purpose of undertaking a thorough review and analysis of the processes utilized in the selection and approval of textbooks and other instructional materials for use in the state's elementary and secondary schools. The task force shall be composed of 18 members. The members shall serve without compensation, but may receive per diem or reimbursement for travel and expenses. The state superintendent shall convene the first meeting of the task force no later than September 1, 2013 and shall designate staff to assist the task force in performing its duties and responsibilities. The task force shall submit a written report of its findings and recommendations to the Senate and House Committees on Education no later than February 1, 2014. The task force shall terminate and all authority for it existence shall end June 30, 2014.
