Murray (SB 210) Act No. 125

<u>Prior law</u> authorized a public entity that is advertising and letting for bid a public works contract to require a deposit from a prime bidder who requests a complete set of bid documents. Provided that the deposit is refundable. <u>Prior law</u> also authorized in instances where the public entity, itself, prepares and distributes the contract documents, to charge a fee for the documents, which shall not exceed the actual cost of reproduction.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and also provides that when the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, itself, prepares and distributes electronic contract documents, it may, in lieu of a deposit, charge a fee for each paper document, not to exceed the actual cost of reproduction.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 5, 2013).
